GUEST INFORMATION SHEET

Please keep in mind that you will be touring a working Navy ship. In order to get a full tour, you may be required to walk up and down ladders, ramps, etc. The following information is provided for your safety during your tour.

- 1. All local COVID guidelines will be followed.
- Wear comfortable clothing: Polo or T-shirts with jeans or shorts. Tennis/running or closed toe, flat, rubber- soled shoes are required. Do not wear heals, sandals or flip-flops. Do not wear necklaces that can get caught and bags that will be too heavy to comfortably carry all day. Guest should not wear skirts as you will be climbing ladders (Navy stairs).
- 3. If you are bringing a handbag or camera case, it will be searched prior to entering any ship.
- 4. No large backpacks, pocket knives, electronic smoking devices, weapons or alcohol will be allowed aboard the U.S. Navy ship.
- 5. Electronic devices are subject to examination for functionality. All visitors will pass through a magnetometer and may be searched as necessary to determine source of metal.
- 6. All adults 18 and over must have a valid state issued ID card with a photo.
- 7. Wheelchairs are allowed on the pier, but are not able to access the ship.
- 8. Strollers will not be allowed on the ship. Parents/guardians must be capable of carrying children up and down steep ladders.
- 9. Cameras (still and video) are permitted.
- 10. The U.S. Navy is not responsible for any personal articles or property lost or stolen while left unattended on the pier.
